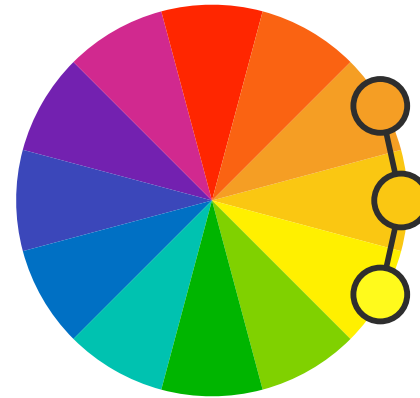
# TONAL

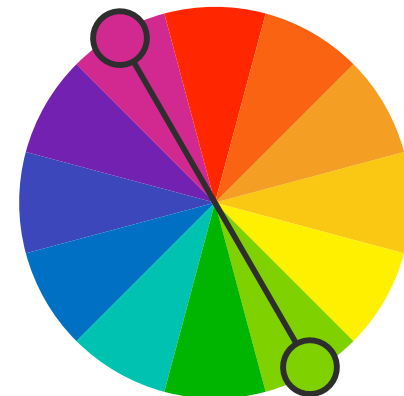
# CONTRASTING

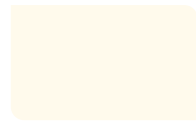
# Oranges

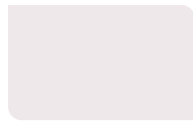
# Reds

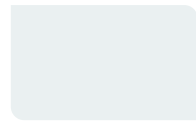
# Blues

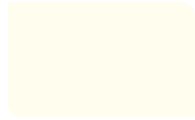
# Neutrals

In terms of psychology, neutrals can be associated with stability, neutrality, and balance. They can also convey a sense of timelessness and classicism.

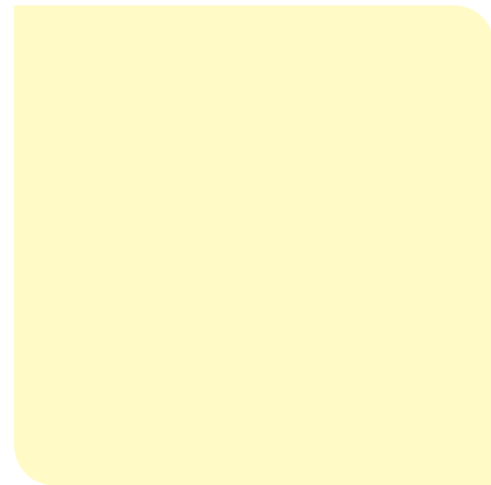
Overall, color neutrals are versatile and essential components of any color palette, providing a foundation upon which other colors can be built.
